Eligibility

- Any youth whom resides in the western states and is an ARBA member is eligible to compete. Attendance at the West Coast Classic is not necessary.

Divisions

- Exhibitor will compete in Junior and Senior divisions.
- Junior division is for exhibitors who are 12 years or younger as of contest date.
- Senior division is for exhibitors who are 13 to 18 years as of the date of the contest.

Rules

- Exhibits must feature a topic related to rabbits or cavies, or feature a rabbit or cavy in their design or use.
- Posters may be a poster board or a display board.
- Photos should be framed and may be matted.
- Photo should not be larger than 8"x10".
- Contestants may only enter one exhibit per class.
- Each entry must be the work of the contestant and must have been completed in the 12 months prior to the competition.
- Your name, address, age, and class entered should be clearly indicated on the outside of your entry.
- It is okay to send your entries with someone else if you cannot attend.
- Entries will be accepted between 8:00 am and 9:00 am and must remain on display until they are released at 3:00 pm. They must be picked up before the showroom closes.
